

CVC of Atlanta – Fall 2020 IMPACT and Special Programming Sponsorship Opportunities

The CVC of Atlanta has several special program opportunities planned for Fall 2020. In addition to hosting the 23rd Annual IMPACT Awards, we will create space for safe and honest dialogue around inclusion in Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR), social injustice and equity through our fall Equitable Dinners series. We will close the year with our Holiday Luncheon. All CVC programs will be virtual until further notice. Following is a brief overview of each program:

Join us for **IMPACT 2020** to recognize the superlative work of corporations that have navigated these unprecedented times by engaging employees, sharing resources and finding innovative ways to support their community. Discover what some of Atlanta's most philanthropic companies are doing – from the C-suite to entry-level employees – to tie volunteerism back to bottom-line business results, and address the ever-changing social landscape of our city and beyond.

The CVC has hosted regular **Solutions Hour** programs since the disruption of COVID-19 began. Topics vary with each program and typically feature a speaker, Q&A and group problem solving dialogue. These programs are attended by an average of 50 CVC members and community leaders, so they provide an excellent opportunity for business-to-business relationship building and discussion. Additionally, a recap is shared with all members after each program, reaching more than 100 of Atlanta's most civically-minded companies. Our next Solutions Hour is scheduled for August 12 and will feature Partnership for Southern Equity Chief Equity Officer (CEqO), Nathaniel Smith.

The CVC will host three **Equitable Dinners** in Fall 2020 which will focus on inclusion in CSR and equity in the communities we serve. The mission of Equitable Dinners Atlanta is to build community, increase understanding and empathy for the experience of people of color, heighten equity awareness, and activate anti-racist action.

The CVC of Atlanta concludes its programming each year with the eagerly anticipated CVC **Holiday Luncheon**. This beloved gathering serves as both a celebration of the collective good works of the metro Atlanta business community as well as a time for the individuals who lead corporate social responsibility and community engagement programs to recharge and be inspired for their work ahead. Our 2020 luncheon will feature a keynote speaker and the presentation of the 2020 Carol D. Reiser Youth Service Awards.

IMPACT 2020

This has been a most unusual year, and companies are thinking about social impact in innovative, new ways. The IMPACT 2020 Awards will recognize different categories than prior years in recognition of current community needs calling out outstanding achievements in corporate volunteer service (for Atlanta-based work) through the following categories:

IMPACT of the Year

Presented to an exemplary corporate-employee volunteer or corporate social responsibility program that went above and beyond in the period between January 1, 2019 and July 1, 2020

Skills-Based Volunteering IMPACT

Presented to an organization in recognition of its efforts to leverage the skills of the company's employees to build operational capacity of nonprofit or community partners while fostering professional growth. Nominations may specifically reference an established skills-based volunteering program or may highlight a company's pivot from in-person to virtual volunteering and CSR efforts due to COVID-19. All projects and programs referenced in the nomination must take place between January 1, 2019 and July 1, 2020.

Social Justice IMPACT

Presented to a company that addressed social justice in a bold and innovative way in the period between January 1, 2019 and July 1, 2020.
